AIM

To be the first team to reach 10 points. Win points by:

- ✔ Silently agreeing with your teammate when the two of you are faced with an awkward question.
- ✔ Second-guessing the decisions made by other teams.

SET UP

Split into teams of two. If you happen to have an odd number of players, one person acts as the Question Master.

Lay the stack of **Squirm Cards** face down on the table. Hand a set of **Agree** and **Disagree Cards** to each team.



Pick a team to start and give them the two blank **Verdict Boards** and pens.



The team to their left must then read out a **Squirm Card**.



LET'S GET PERSONAL

The team with the **Verdict Boards** must now decide which of them best fits the answer to the question on the card. No matter how uncomfortable things get, the two players cannot discuss the question with each other.

They each secretly write down their name or their teammate's name on their Verdict Board and place it face down on the table.

Meanwhile, the other teams are doing their best to predict the outcome – will the team in the spotlight agree or disagree? Feel free to have a good, noisy discussion with your teammate about what you think they will decide upon and why (to embarrass them as much as possible). When ready, each team plays an Agree or Disagree Card and puts it face down on the table.

THE BIG REVEAL

One by one, each team flips over their Agree or Disagree Card.

Now the team that had to face the awkward question flip over their Verdict Boards.



Both players decided that Dan was the better looking of the two (Congrats, Dan!). Since they agreed and wrote the same name, they score 2 points for their team. If they had disagreed, they would've scored 0 points.

As for the other teams, if they predicted the result correctly, they win 1 point. If they got it wrong, they get zilch.

Tally up the points on the **Score Board**, hand the Verdict Boards over to the next team and get a new Squirm Card ready. Keep on playing until a team reaches 10 points.

DON'T FORGET!

The better you know the players, the easier it is to expose their most embarrassing secrets. Feel free to play a "custom question" round, where you make up your own questions for maximum awkwardness.
