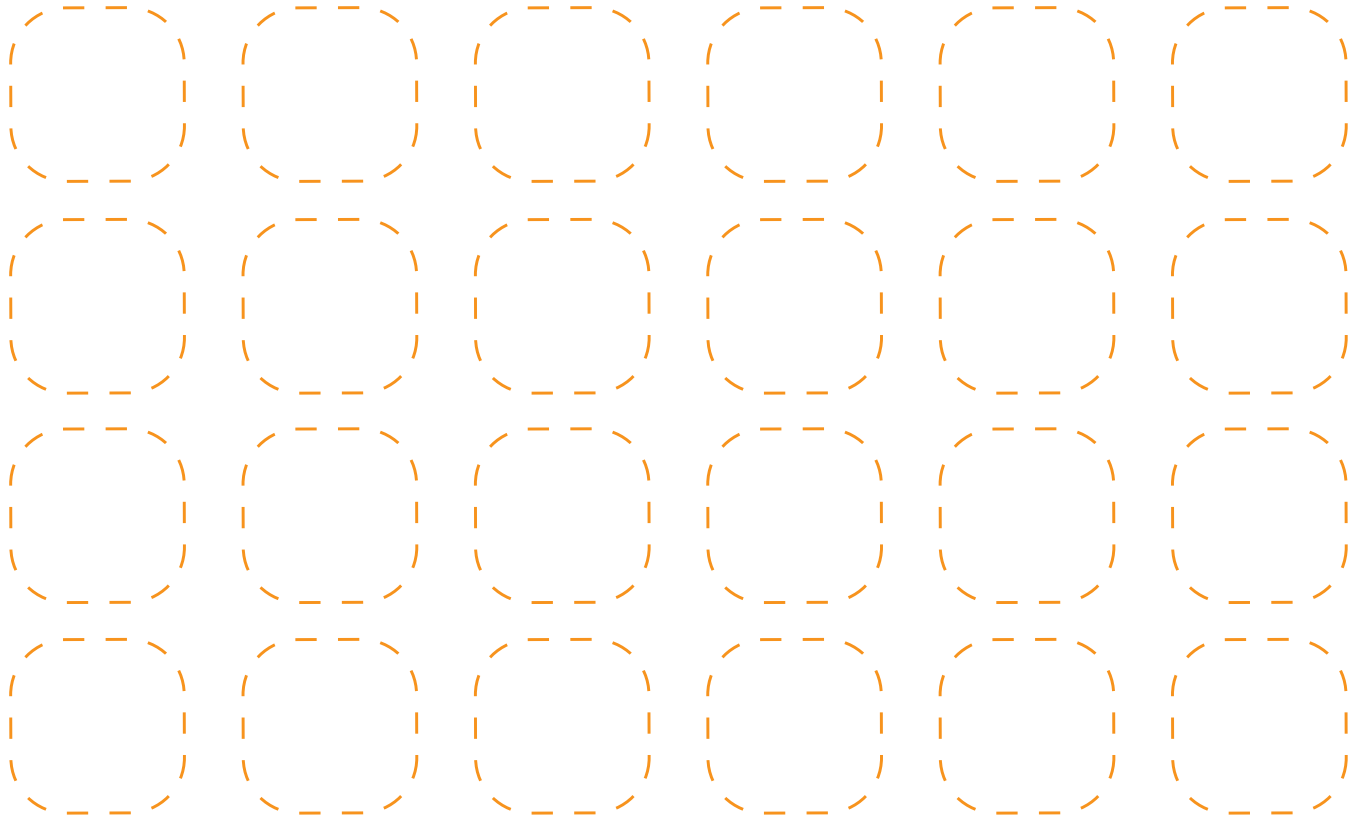




letter memory



1. Find twelve pairs of matching letters in your My First game.
2. Lay them face down, mix them up, and place on grid.
3. Turn over any two tiles. If they match, keep them, if not, turn them back over and try to remember where they were for your next turn.
4. Watch the other players turn over their letters.
5. The game is over when all letters have been paired.
